Pediatric vision coverage

All of ConnectiCare's fully insured small group and individual plans include pediatric vision services for members under the age of 26.

These benefits include:

- Routine eye exam – including a refraction
- Frames and lenses
 - Frame options:**
 - Collection frames – standard frames allowable under Medicare
 - Non-collection frames – all other frames not allowable under Medicare
 - Lens options:**
 - Polycarbonate
 - Scratch-resistant coating
 - Ultra-violet coating
 - Anti-reflective coating
 - Solid tint/gradient/photochromic
- Prescription contact lenses – hard or soft lenses, disposable lenses for first-time users, and fittings

Coverage includes one pair of eyeglasses (lenses and frames) per year or contact lenses which include one fitting and set of lenses per year.

ConnectiCare's standard vision exclusions and limitations apply. There is no coverage for:

- Eye glasses and contact lenses for members age 26 and older
- Eye surgeries and procedures primarily for the purpose of correcting refractive defects of the eyes, including, but not limited to: laser surgery, orthokeratology and radial keratotomy
- Vision therapy and vision training
